We have deep roots in KGC and we're working to bring this beneficial project to our hometown.








CAMPUS & JOHN ECONOMIC IMPACT

Dahlgren West will bring new, high-paying employment opportunities and consistent, substantial annual tax revenue to King George County – with minimal impacts on public resources.


